Remembering Our Teachers

Dear Jerry,

Because Dr. Buchwalter seems to be a never ending story for Taft alums of the 1940s, let me add a few details about her that haven't been mentioned.

As a history teacher who has also interviewed elderly family members for genealogy, I know memories of events of fifty to fifty-five years ago can be faulty. With that disclaimer in mind, let me add some items from my memory. First, I recollect her first name was Grace, although no student and few of her faculty peers would have addressed her so. German is much more formal than English, and she was German to the core.

Second, I remember from some unknown source, that she came out of the Amish/Old Order Mennonite group that lived around Arthur, Illinois. I would guess she came from Old Order Mennonite stock because they embrace the modern world to a greater extent than do the Amish.

Third, before WWII, Dr. Buchwalter spent her summers in Weimar in Thuringie. It is the site of Goethe and Schiller's homes, the birthplace of the ill-fated Weimar Republic, which preceded Adolph Hitler, and most infamously the WWII concentration camp Buchenwald. Because Weimar was in East Germany after WWII, I doubt if Dr. Buchwalter ever visited again. She obviously loved it there prior to WWII.

Fourth, as unbelievable as it may sound to her students, she did marry about the time she retired. When I passed my graduate German reading exam in the summer of 1954, I wrote Dr. Buchwalter at Taft's address (5600 N. Natoma then) to thank her for the preparation she had given me in those years of high school German. I received a nice note from Mrs. Grace O'Neal. At the time I was struck by the fact that such an Irish name was completely out of character from such a German woman.

One last set of comments and I'll close. I can't recall a comment in

the Taft Alumni Newsletter about Dr. Buchwalter that doesn't ring true. She treated and probably viewed her students as a Marine drill sergeant treats a group of raw recruits. As I look back on my experience at Taft, I have two major regrets. I wish I had taken a fourth year of German with Dr. Buchwalter. On my various visits to Germany as I stammer a tourist German, I frequently think of the Doctor and how much better my German would have been with another year of her drill. She indeed was a drillmaster. My second regret is I didn't take personal typing, and even in this age of computers, the keyboard still escapes me. Thank God there are still books to read, and people like you can still read script. Thanks for your forbearance.

I've been meaning to send someone a note for many years, praising the great education I received at Taft (and Ebinger Elementary School too.) Hi Jerry:

My two-plus years at Taft, following a year at Schurz, were not happy ones. I was never in serious trouble but I had an attitude and interests that did not suit the time and place. I was, for example, the only male in the two typing courses I took, and I had no interest in athletics. I read as many as five books a week from the school library, but had little interest in class work. More and more I cut classes and hung out with other misfits and my grades continued to fall. I was a senior when, a few weeks after Pearl Harbor, I was asked to leave. I was thrown out. It seemed to me then that other than my typing skill the entire time had been a waste.

The only high school teacher who ever took more than a passing interest in me or tried to arrest the downward spiral that I was in was **Janice Fink**, a Jewish lady of forty-some years with a plain face and, as

I recall, an eye problem of some sort. Whatever her appearance, she had a heart as big as a watermelon. She was my junior-level English teacher for two semesters and became convinced that I had talent as a writer.

At her urging (for I was not then competitive in any way) I entered the monthly essay contest sponsored by the school newspaper, the *Taft Tribune*. The assigned topic for the essay was "How can you show American spirit on Halloween?" I thought the topic was banal if not stupid and I entered only to please her, and I won. I must add that she was one of the judges. *[See copy of article at right]*

...I won a dollar's worth of Activity Tickets, good for school events such as intra-mural basketball games, Saturday football games and the weekly dances held in the school gym. Most of these affairs cost a dime. The athletic events interested me not at all, although the dances did. One needed a sport jacket and tie, though for the dances, and I lacked the jacket. So I never picked up the tickets and never again entered the essay contest. Today we would say I was protesting, although I've no idea now what I thought I was protesting, unless it was the parental decision that had forced me to attend Taft when I would have preferred to remain at Schurz.

I may have embarrassed Miss Fink by not picking up the tickets, and I surely disappointed her in other ways. Lord knows, she tried. My great regret is that I never did write anything for her worthy of her belief in me. The only way I could make it right was to remember her with fondness. I did, and I still do.

One-Man Band

When he heard that boom boxes were replacing buglers at military burials, vet Tom Day issued a clarion call

The first time Tom Day played "Taps" at a military funeral he was a 10-year-old with an adult-size case of nerves. "I messed up, but nobody seemed to mind," says Day, now 62, who performed the solemn ritual for the family of a neighbor who had died in the Korean War. "They were moved that there was a live bugler. I never forgot that."

Last year, when Day learned that a shortage of buglers—only 500 to cover the roughly 1,700 veterans who die daily—was forcing the Department of Defense to use recorded music at most

burials, he took action. Day created Bugles Across America, a nonprofit association he runs out of his Berwyn, Ill., bungalow using his own funds. So far he has recruited 450 buglers in 47 states, and funeral directors around the U.S. know to call him or check his Web site for volunteers. "Vets are heroes," says Day, a sales rep for the Illinois State Lottery. "They deserve better than a boom box." Day's troops share his dedication.

"I'm a saxophone player, but I'm learning the bugle to help out," says Jacklyn Raymei 15, the youngest

volunteer. "I feel it's my duty."

Day began his military career at Taft High School in Chicago, where he joined the Army ROTC. He went on to become a Marine sergeant and later served as a public information officer for the Navy and a bugler for the Coast Guard. Wed to second wife Donna, now 49, since 1978, he has two grown children.

No armchair recruiter, Day has ushered more than 550 of his fellow vets into the hereafter. Those left behind appreciate the special attention. Says Corinne Aultman, 53, whose uncle, a World War II vet, recently died: "When Tom played 'Taps,' it was so beautiful it made me cry."
